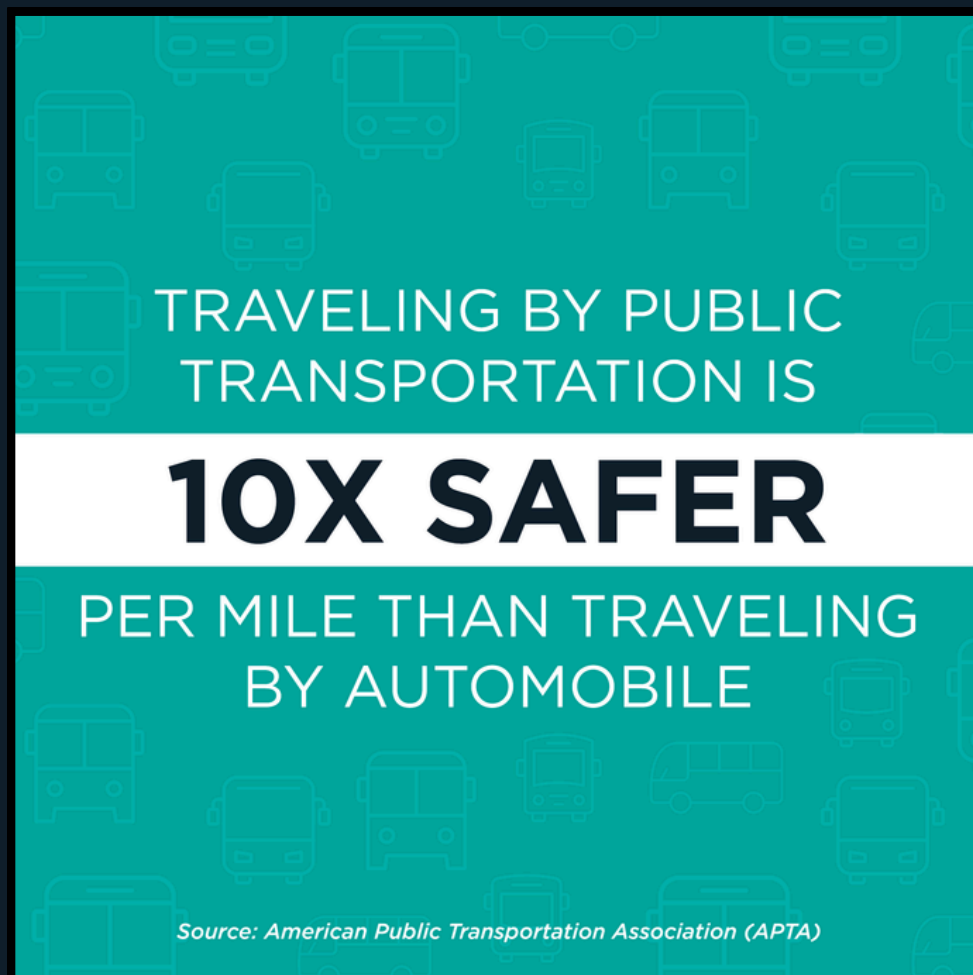


GoTriangle Safety — Staying Vigilant on the Road

Route WRX Gets a Major Upgrade — More Trips, More Connections!

Starting November 9, Route WRX is getting a big boost! Service between Wake Forest, Triangle Town Center, and Downtown Raleigh will now run hourly on weekdays from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m.

GoTriangle will begin operating the route directly (previously run by GoRaleigh), bringing more consistency and better regional connections.

What's New:

- All-day service: Hourly weekday trips connecting Wake Forest and Triangle Town Center.
- Peak express trips to Downtown Raleigh:
 - Morning departures from Wake Forest at 5:40 a.m. and 6:40 a.m. to the Raleigh Union Station Bus Facility (RUS Bus).
 - Afternoon return trips from Downtown Raleigh at 5:30 p.m. and 6:30 p.m. back to Wake Forest.

Easy transfers:

- At Triangle Town Center, connect to GoRaleigh Route 1 (every 10 minutes) for Downtown Raleigh, or Route 25L for North Raleigh.
- In Wake Forest, transfer to Wake Forest Microtransit or Rolesville MicroLink for neighborhood connections.
- New start and end point: Trips to Downtown Raleigh will now begin and end at the Raleigh Union Station Bus Facility, offering convenient access to Amtrak service and smoother transfers between local and regional routes.

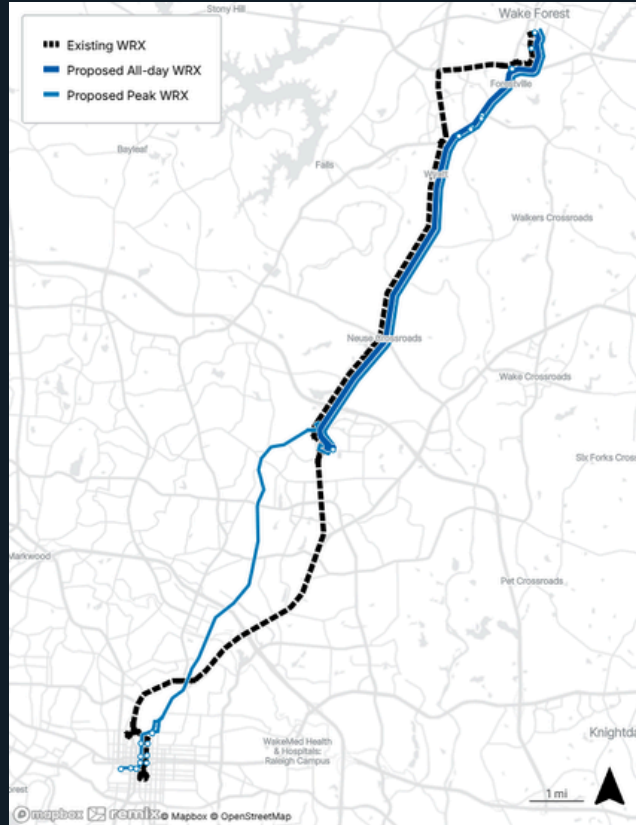

Route ZWX Expands — Hourly Service from Wendell & Zebulon to Downtown Raleigh

Starting November 9, GoTriangle is enhancing service in eastern Wake County with the launch of hourly weekday trips on Route ZWX, connecting Wendell, Zebulon, and Downtown Raleigh.

This expanded service will make it easier for riders in these growing communities to commute, run errands, and connect with the rest of the Triangle—offering more flexibility and reliability throughout the day.

What's New:

- Hourly weekday service between Wendell, Zebulon, and Downtown Raleigh.
- All-day connections to key destinations across eastern Wake County and Downtown Raleigh.
- Improved reliability and expanded travel options for commuters and local riders.
- Enhanced coordination with GoRaleigh and GoWake Access services for easier transfers

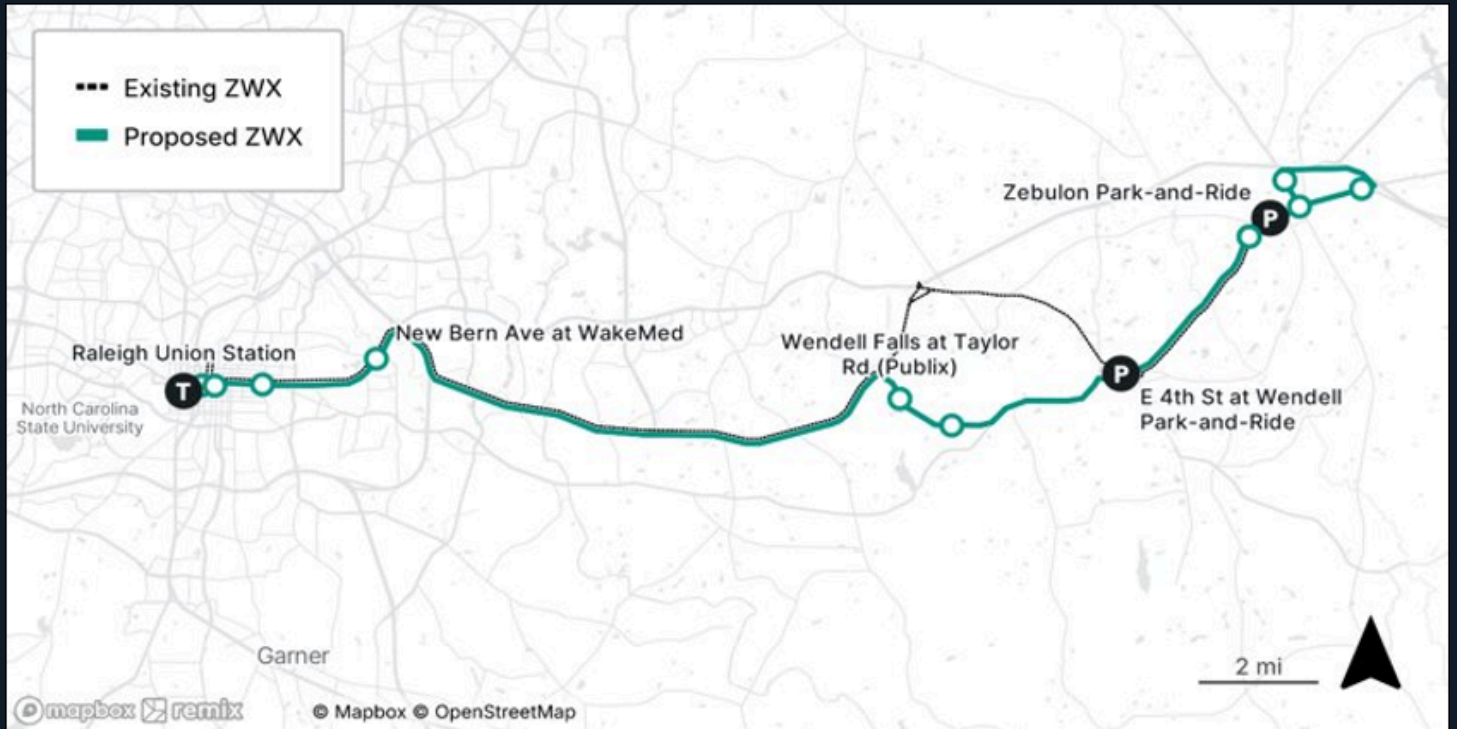

GoRaleigh Service Updates — More Frequent & Reliable Trips

Key Updates by Route:

- **Route 1 - Capital**
 - Frequency increased to every 10 minutes during the day on weekdays.
 - Early morning and late evening trips: every 20 minutes.
 - Weekend service: every 15 minutes during the day and every 30 minutes in the early morning and late evening.
 - Three stops on Route 1 will be removed to streamline travel.
- **Route 7 - South Saunders**
 - 15-minute frequency extended later into the evening and on weekends.
 - Early morning and late evening: 30-minute frequency.
- **Route 15 - WakeMed**
 - 15-minute frequency extended later into the evening and on weekends.
 - Early morning and late evening: 30-minute frequency.
 - Small alignment change to improve service.
- **Route 33L - Knightdale**
 - Weekday service adjusted to 45-minute frequency.
- **Route 18L - Barwell-New Hope**
 - Saturday schedule updated to better align with Route 18.
- **Route 5 & Route 9**
 - Minor timepoint adjustments to prevent buses from bunching and improve reliability.

GoRaleigh Station Platform Updates

Starting October 12, GoRaleigh Station has updated platform assignments to make boarding smoother and improve reliability. Check the new platform for your route before your next trip!

Platform Assignments:

- Platform A: Routes 7 | 9 | 20 | 55X
- Platform B: Routes 5 | 11 | 17 | 18 | 19 | 21
- Platform C: Routes 3 | 6 | 10
- Platform D: Routes 2 | 4 | 8 | 12 | 15 | 16
- Platform E: Routes 1 | 40X
- Blount Street Platform: Routes 100 | ZWX
- Wilmington Street Platform: Routes R-Line | FRX

These updates help riders find their bus faster and make connections more reliable across Raleigh's transit network.

GoDurham Service Updates – Effective November 1, 2025

GoDurham is implementing its next round of service changes to improve connections, frequency, and overall reliability across Durham County. These changes affect Routes 3, 16, 8, 12, and a new Route 13, supporting Durham’s long-term transit goals.

Key Updates by Route:

- **Route 3**
 - Runs every 15 minutes to Glenn View Station Walmart.
 - Combined service with Route 16 provides better-than-15-minute frequency between Durham Station and The Village.
- **Route 16 (replacing current Route 3B)**
 - Operates every 30 minutes, improving on the previous 60-minute service.
- **Route 8**
 - Rerouted to serve Riddle Rd and Cornwallis Rd.
 - Service to Unity Village, Capps St, and Hearthside will shift to the new Route 13.
- **Route 12**
 - Rerouted to serve NC 55.
 - Frequency increased to every 30 minutes (up from 60 minutes).
 - Route 12B eliminated.
 - Service along NC 54 discontinued; riders can transfer to GoTriangle Route 800 at NC 54 & NC 55.
- **New Route 13 (replacing current Route 3C)**
 - Connects The Village to NCCU and Durham Tech, providing updated access for students and local residents.

GoCary Fall 2025 Service Changes – More Connections Across Cary

GoCary is expanding its network this fall with two new routes and updates to existing service, improving access between Cary, Apex, and Raleigh for work, school, shopping, and recreation.

New Routes

- **Route 2 – Connecting Cary to Raleigh**
 - Links downtown Cary, NC State University, and the North Carolina State Fairgrounds.
 - Includes 38 stops along key corridors like North Harrison Avenue, Northeast Maynard Road, Chapel Hill Road, Corporate Center Drive, and Trinity Road.
 - Connects with NC State Wolfline and GoRaleigh Route 27L for regional travel.
 - Serves students, faculty, residents, and event-goers traveling to popular destinations like Carter–Finley Stadium and Drive Shack.
- **Route 9 – Expanding Local Service Between Cary and Apex**
 - Replaces the Apex–Cary Express (ACX) with local service along High House Road, Old Apex Road, and North Salem Street.
 - Offers 34 stops connecting neighborhoods, schools, businesses, and shopping centers.
 - Connects with GoApex Route 1 and GoTriangle Route 305 to expand travel options throughout the region.





SERVICE CHANGES cont

GoCary Fall 2025 Service Changes – More Connections Across Cary

Service Hours & Frequency

- Monday–Saturday: Every 30 minutes from 6:00 AM – 7:00 PM; hourly 7:00 PM – 10:00 PM
- Sunday: Every 60 minutes from 7:00 AM – 9:00 PM

Route 1 – Realignment for Better Access

- New stops along Crossroads Boulevard and Jones Franklin Road near Sheetz.
- Shared stops with GoTriangle Route 305 along Dillard Drive for better regional connections.
- Removed stops: Dillard Dr at Walnut St, Columbus Ave, and Jones Franklin Rd.

Accessibility & Infrastructure Enhancements

- All new and upgraded stops meet ADA standards and include lighting where feasible.
- 38 existing bus stops across the system will be upgraded with new concrete pads.
- New crosswalks and pedestrian signals are being added, including Walnut Street and Donaldson Drive, to improve safety.
- Construction began May 2025 and is expected to take 10 months
